EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

TELE RADIOLOGY PROPOSAL, ASSAM

Expression of Interest is invited for providing Tele-Radiology Services in Assam in 11 District Hospitals i.e. (Kokrajhar, Dhubri, Barpeta, Mangaldoi, MMCH, Guwahati, Nagaon, Haflong, Jorhat, Lakhimpur, Cachar and Hailakandi). These services will be provided for tests performed through CT scan, X-ray and USG, already installed in the District Hospitals. There will be a Central Data centre at Guwahati which will work as data storage for all Tele-Radiology cases.

Assam Government of Assam will provide the required space in 11 District Hospitals, the medical equipments i.e. CT Scan/X-Ray/USG and the data connectivity between districts and Guwahati. The service provider shall set up the required Tele-Radiology infrastructure including capturing of the data from the X-Ray/CT Scan/USB machine and conversion into electronic form (DICOM Compatible), software and hardware for Tele-Radiology data transmission, data transmission within the district hospital and running of the same by deploying appropriate Person Power. The service provider shall also provide Diagnostic Reports through qualified experts on the tests so performed.

The Tele-Radiology Units in each district hospital and Central Data Centre based out of Guwahati will be under the Management of the Service Provider and cater to the patients referred by the District Hospital/coming directly. A reasonable rate will be charged from the patients for the service as prescribed by the Govt.

Only those organizations will be eligible to participate who have at least 3 years of experiences in Tele-Radiology/Tele-Medicine and have a minimum Annual Turnover of Rs. 50.00 crore each for the last 3 (three) years.

The Service Provider shall be responsible for installation and running the services for which cost implications will be indicated each item separately. State Govt. shall fund the capital and operating expenditure. All equipments installed shall remain the property of Govt. of Assam.

Interested organizations may submit the EoI within 31st January 2012. They shall have to furnish a letter of intent with the following details:-

1. Financial soundness as reflected in the Financial Statement for the last 3 years ending March 31st, 2010 (Annual turnover of at least Rs. 50.00 crore in each of last 3 years).
2. Detailed Project Plan for Tele-Radiology implementation with the following details



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- a. Detailed architecture design of Tele-Radiology infrastructure along with software and hardware specifications.
- b. Specification and make/model of equipments to be installed including costs.
- c. Detailed manpower proposed for operating the facility including costs.
- d. Details of qualified experts including qualifications, experience & costs.

EoI should be submitted to the Mission Director NRHM, Assam, Khanapara, Guwahati 22 along with a non-refundable amount of Rs. 20.00 lakhs in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of Mission Director NRHM, Assam payable at Guwahati.

Government of Assam reserves the right to accept or reject any application and cancel the bidding process at any time without any liability and assigning any reason thereof. The proposals retained after the scrutiny will be considered for the pre-bid meeting and for subsequent process of bidding.
