**Expression of Interest (EOI) for Common Biomedical Waste
Treatment Facility**

National Rural Health Mission invites EOI for rolling out the Bio -Medical Waste Disposal System in District Hospital, Community Health Centre and First Referral Unit in all the 27 districts from organizations having **Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility** in the state as per Bio – Medical Waste (Management & Handling) amendment Rule 2003.

The Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) must have a set up and authorization for collection, reception, storage and disposal of bio medical waste generated from hospitals. The CBWTF must be have a incinerator, Autoclave/Microwave/Hydroclave, Shredder, Sharp pit/Encapsulation, Effluent Treatment Plant and other equipments and accessories.

Requirement:

The interested parties should have:

1. Authorization under Bio – Medical Waste (Management & Handling) amendment Rule 2003 from Assam Pollution Control Board.
2. Proper Registration with Govt. authorities.
3. Organizational set up in the district (s).

4. Fixed Asset of Rs. 20.00 lakh having up-to –date statement of 2 years Audited Accounts as on 31st March 2008.
5. At least 2 years of experience in handling of Biomedical Waste Management in the district (s).

The Organization has to submit:

1. Particulars of the organization
2. Details of works / experience in Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility with supporting documents.
3. The district preference.
4. Description of process involved Biomedical Waste Disposal i.e. Collection, Transportation, Treatment and Final Disposal of Bio Medical Waste
5. Detail budget on bed wise/ institution wise rate per day/ per month.
6. Copy of PAN Number
7. Copy of the authorization letter under Bio – Medical Waste (Management & Handling) amendment Rule 2003 from Assam Pollution Control Board.
8. Registration under Central Pollution Control Board , Delhi
9. License from District Municipal Corporation for Biomedical Waste Management
10. Any other information, which may be useful in the process of Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Disposal
